


# Milestones 2025

## MoU with Mody University

## Grading of PITC



The Directorate General of Training, under the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE), has announced on 18<sup>th</sup> July the latest grading for Palriwala ITI. We are pleased to share that our institute has achieved a rating of **6.4 out of 10**, a significant improvement from our previous score of 4.3 (2023-24) out of 10.

## New AI & Coding Course

A new AI & Coding program was launched to equip students with emerging digital skills, including machine learning fundamentals, prompt engineering, application development, and coding logic. Students' projects, described below, successfully created varied apps.

## **Local Sponsorships of Women for Skill Development**

- **Virender Sahdev Foundation:** Sponsored training for 6 economically disadvantaged female trainees in the one-year Computer Operator and Programming Assistant trade.
- **Dr. Sahdev Choudhary Foundation:** Sponsored 7 trainees in the one-year Computer Operator and Programming Assistant trade.

These young women are from some of the most challenging socio-economic backgrounds in the region. Many of their families are dependent on irregular daily-wage work in manual labour, street vending or small shops, while some are being raised by single parents or relatives due to difficult family circumstances.

Despite such hardships and lack of financial resources, these young women have shown exceptional resilience and ambition. A few among them are National-level athletes, representing their district and state in sports such as basketball, softball, and kabaddi.

Through the sponsorship extended by the **Virender Sahdev Foundation** and **Dr. Sahdev Choudhary Foundation**, PERTS is able to provide essential computer and digital skills that will allow the young women to pursue stable employment, support their families, and build dignified and independent futures beyond the limitations of poverty.






## A GRAND AND GRACEFUL INAUGURATION


